



## Patient Instructions- Inhalation Therapy

Your HealthCare provider has prescribed a compounded medication for inhalation therapy, which will be custom made to fit your needs. A pharmacy representative may contact you prior to compounding your prescription to discuss allergies and information pertinent to filling your order.

The pharmacy may also contact your insurance provider to verify coverage and possible co-payment. It is important that you use this prescription exactly as directed to ensure that you experience its maximum benefits. Please follow the instructions below, and contact the pharmacy to speak with a pharmacist if you have any questions.

### Your package should include:

- NasoNeb® Nasal Nebulizer Kit (Instruction Manual and DVD included)
- Medication Capsules - **DO NOT INGEST CAPSULES.**
- Saline Respules



### Instructions:

Review the NasoNeb® instruction manual for SETUP AND OPERATION instructions.

1. Empty one medication capsule (unless directed differently from physician) into Nasal Nebulizer Cup.
2. Add single saline dose
3. Two plumes of medication will enter your nasal cavity; you may feel a flow of air coming back out of your mouth.
4. Turn the compressor off when the main canister is empty.

**Therapy should be complete in approximately 1-2 minutes.**
